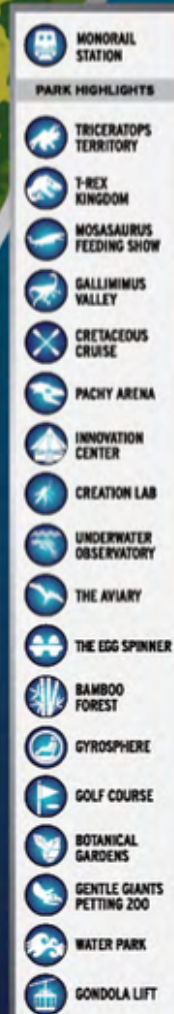

By asking and answering layers of questions about our JW island, a multi-dimensional, highly realized world will emerge . . .

- Where do the JW employees live? Shop? Play? Do schools exist for their children? A hospital? Do they have different modes of transportation than JW park guests? Where are they allowed to go on the island?
- How is the Island fueled? Where are power plants, wind and solar farms? Where is fuel stored? How is it distributed?
- How are animals transported? Is there an engineered system to house and transport aquatic animals?
- What is Underground? Mechanical tunnels? Natural Caverns? Employee Corridors? Engineered and/or Natural Waterways? INGEN Bunkers / storage?

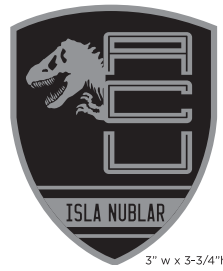
JW Film Version

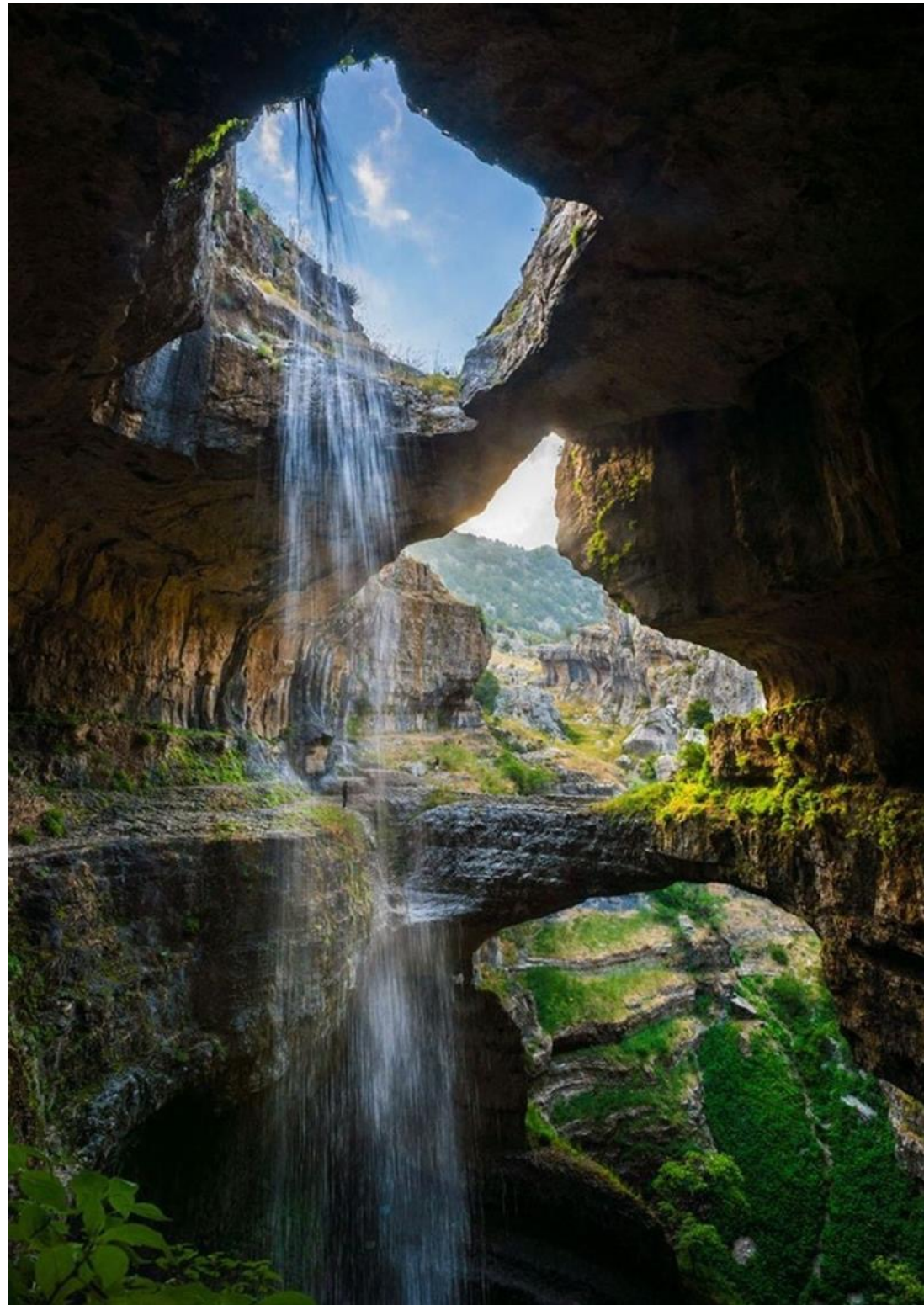

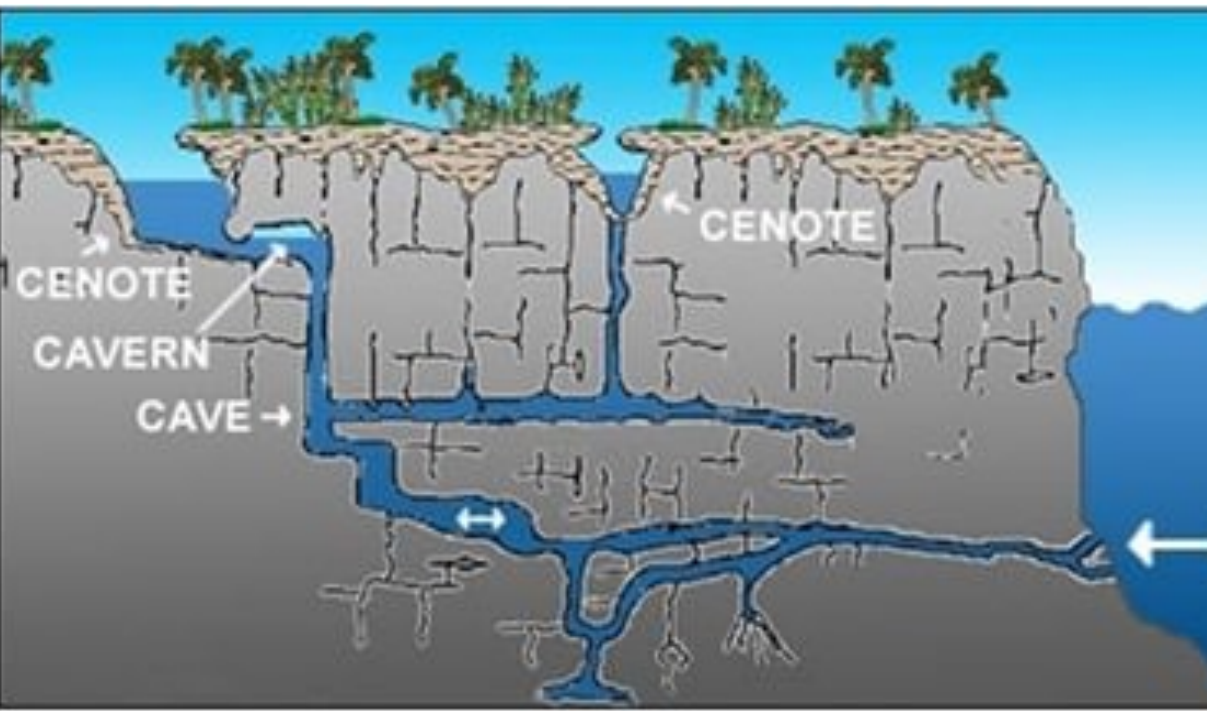
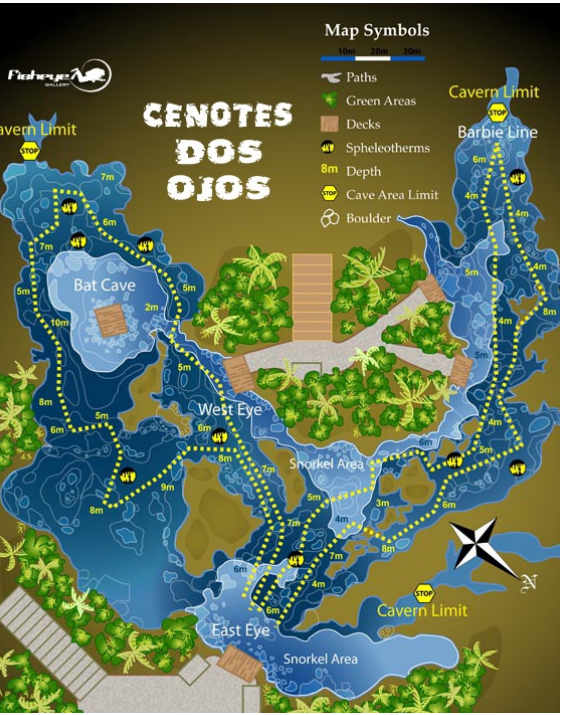
